CALL FOR INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY FOR KABYLIA

To the Secretary-General of the United Nations

To the UN Security Council

To the European Union, the African Union

This call is an SOS

Kabylie is on fire (wild fires) since 07/07/2017. It has already recorded deaths, hundreds of houses burned, more than a million olive trees reduced to ashes and tens of thousands of hectares ravaged by flames. The air is unbreathable, the temperatures are those of a hell, and the water from the Kabylia dams is sent elsewhere, while Kabylie, without means to face the furnace, dies of thirst.

In spite of this calamity the Algerian State does not mobilize any means to face the situation; neither to fight fire nor to help the victims.

Everyone knows in Kabylie that it is the Algerian military that, like every summer since 2004, turn into arsonists on the orders of Algiers.

The passivity of the Algerian colonial power in the face of this ecological and human catastrophe, combined with the fact that fire departures, limited only to the Kabyle territory, are coordinated to the minute, suggests that if the Algerian government were not to do so The sponsor, he is at least an accomplice. This is another form of genocide that he is carrying out.

In order not to launch free charges against Algeria, Anavad is calling for the establishment of an International Commission of Inquiry to identify the perpetrators of these uncontrollable fires and their contractors.

Meanwhile, the situation is very serious and requires the mobilization of large means to extinguish the fires and to relieve the victims.

It is for this purpose that the Anavad (Provisional Kabyle Government in Exile) appeals to all countries to release emergency aid to be given to an ad hoc body under the auspices of the United Nations.

We will have to rebuild the destroyed houses and replant 5 to 10 million olive trees to repair nature.

The Provisional Government Kabyle stands at the disposal of every country outraged by the abandonment of Kabylia by the Algerian State, which not only no longer fulfills its international obligations towards its citizens, but worse, gives them up to fire and death. It is ready to cooperate fully in the management of the ongoing disaster.

Waiting for your immediate intervention in Kabylia, please hear the cry of distress of an unarmed, democratic, peaceful and very human people, by way of my sincere greetings.
